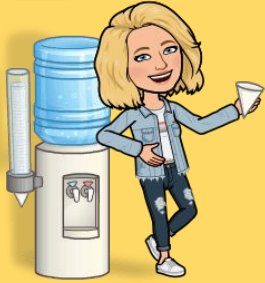

A Quick Intro

Creative Commons is a non-profit that helps sharing + reuse of creativity & knowledge via free legal and technological tools. These tools are not alternatives to copyright laws, rather they work alongside them.

TRADITIONAL COPYRIGHT SYSTEM



VS

CREATIVE COMMONS

- Allows you to easily give people the right to share or even build upon your work
- Allows you to reserve only those rights that you want.

PUBLIC DOMAIN
CC 0

This is not a 'license', but a 'public domain declaration', in which you give up all copyright (but retain 'moral rights', if you can't give those up in your legal jurisdiction) and allow people to make any kind of use of the work without conditions.

THE SYMBOLS



ATTRIBUTION
Requires acknowledgment of the author / source (this is a necessary part of all the six licenses)



SHARE-A-LIKE
Usage is allowed only if the work to which it refers is licensed under the same 'open' license.



NON COMMERCIAL
Usage is allowed only for non-commercial purposes.



NO DERIVATIVE
Creating 'derivatives' is not allowed.
