It is estimated that 30% or more of Americans will have to switch jobs or develop digital skills that technological advances such as artificial intelligence (AI) and automation bring to the workplace. Most of those workers will be Americans with high school diplomas or less (Digital Literacy Resource Guide for Adult Learners, 2012). A key skill to teach digital literacy is photovisual literacy. This is the ability to know where to click or move within a website. A resource that can be used to teach this is an infographic. See below for an example website that shares a daily infographic. Incorporating this into your daily routine can assist your learners with the ability to access visual information and teach critical digital skills.

The <u>Daily Infographic</u> is a website that posts a new infographic daily. You can search for an infographic by topic, and sign up to have a new one sent to you each day. Use this <u>infographic</u> on the total solar eclipse that is expected for April 8, 2024, as a shared whole-class reading. Some important observances this month include Chinese Language Day on April 20th, English Language Day on April 23, and Mother Earth Day on April 22.
