Foundational Training (required)

Foundational courses are designed to introduce participants to the College and Career Readiness Standards (CCRS). Completion of both the 101 and 102 courses is required to fulfill the foundational training and may be taken in any available format.

Implementation Training (recommended)

Implementation courses are designed to support the integration of the CCRS in the classroom. While offerings may vary each year, completion of the ELA 100-Level Series is **required** before enrolling in implementation courses.

Completion of Foundational Training (prerequisite)

Implementation Courses

Implementation sessions are offered virtually and vary in length. Each course requires the completion of a designated assignment, and upon completion, participants will receive a certificate. Courses are clearly labeled as "Implementation training" courses.

- To earn a Certificate of Completion, participants must completed **all** required assignments/activites and achieve a <u>final</u> score of 80% or higher.
