


## CCRS MATH TRAINING Learning Pathways

## Foundational Training (required)

Foundational courses are designed to introduce participants to the College and Career Readiness Standards (CCRS). Completion of **both** the 101 and 102 courses is required to fulfill the foundational training and may be taken in any available format.



## Implementation Training (recommended)

Implementation courses are designed to support the integration of the CCRS in the classroom. While offerings may vary each year, completion of the Math 100-Level Series is **required** before enrolling in implementation courses.

Completion of Foundational Training (prerequisite)

Implementation Courses

Implementation courses are offered virtually and vary in length. Each course requires the completion of a designated assignment, and upon completion, participants will receive a certificate. Courses are clearly labeled as "Implementation training" offerings.

- To earn a Certificate of Completion, participants must completed **all** required assignments/activites and achieve a <u>final</u> score of 80% or higher.
- Upon completing the courses, participants will be able to view, download, or print their individual course Certificate of Completion through their Learning Stream account.
